


Days out from Danby using Moorsbus Services , 3rd May - 29th September 2019

Hello everyone and welcome to Moorsbus 2019; public transport arranged and funded by passengers for the North York Moors and surrounding area. Moorsbuses are accessible for wheelchairs, accept ENCTS bus passes, children travel free with a ticket holder, and well-behaved dogs are welcome. Moorsbus Community Interest Company and Friends of Moorsbus are all volunteers. We started in 2014, and we are gradually building up public transport. Of course we really need passengers, because your fares, passes and donations help to fund and expand the services. We hope you have some great days out on Moorsbus in 2019. Full service details can be found on www.moorsbus.org, and we can also work with you to produce special printed information for Danby residents. We run Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays from 3rd May to 29th September. The services are slightly different each day. Services start from York, Redcar, Malton, Darlington and Easingwold, we hope they are also useful for people wanting to visit you at Danby. Here is our network map:-

Fridays and Saturdays

To **Hutton-le-Hole**, Depart 12.55, get there 13.22, leave 15.05, back at Danby station 15.30.

What's there? Cafes, church, pub, icecreams, gift shops, Ryedale Folk Museum, short walks,

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Evening and night out, Friday TO Saturday!

To **York**, Depart 16.44 arrive York Youth Hostel 18.50 (via Exhibition Square & Railway Stn). Get up early to catch bus back on Saturday morning, 9.10 at Youth Hostel or 9.25 at York Station, arrive back 11.35am. Or stay in Malton or Pickering and return on M3 on Saturdays or M6 on Sundays.

Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays

To Danby National Park Centre. Fridays 11.35, 15.30, Saturdays 11.35, 15.30, 17.05, Sundays & Bank Hols 10.26, 12.32, 16.50 **What's there?** The Lovely Inspired By art gallery, shop, cafe, bird hides, children's activities and play areas indoors and out, exhibitions, outdoor sculptures, special events such as a Rhythm and Brews beer festival on 14th & 15th September, talks, workshops, walks

Saturdays only

To **Rievaulx and/or Helmsley.** Depart 10.10, arrive H 11.15, R 11.25. Leave R 15.12, H15.22. Arrive back 17.05. **What's there** Rievaulx Abbey and shop/cafe (English Heritage), Rievaulx Terraces (National Trust). Two mile walk Rievaulx to Helmsley on the Cleveland Way. At Helmsley there is the Castle, Walled Garden, lots of gift shops and cafes, several charity shops, several pubs and a small Brewery, an outdoor heated swimming pool, a Birds of Prey Centre and Ice Creams.

Saturdays only

A grand tour of the North York Moors Depart 10 am, arrive back 12.11, **Just stay on the bus**, and it will take you all the way around via Hutton-Le-Hole, Kirkbymoorside, Helmsley, Riexaulx, Stokesley, Great Ayton and Guisborough. Great scenery but no toilet stops.

Saturday to Sunday & Bank Hol

A night stay in **Redcar.** Leave Danby 17.20. Direct return 08.50, or later changing Guisborough.

Sundays and Bank Holidays

To **Pickering and/or Dalby Forest** Depart 10 am to go via Kirkbymoorside, arrive 10.52, or 10.47 via Rosedale, arrive 11.36. Leave Pickering 16.00 (via Rosedale) or 17.10. (via Kirkbymoorside). Depart Pickering 11.46 for Dalby Forest on the M7, leave Dalby 14.07 or 15.32.

What's there? At Dalby Forest there are walks, cycle hire, "Go Ape", a junior go ape, a great outdoor play area for children, a shop, exhibitions, or a walk back to Thornton-le-Dale to Moors Deli, the Chocolate Shop, pubs, cafes and gift shops. Pickering has Beck Isle Musuem, the Castle, & woods, North York Moors (Steam) Railway, charity shops, cafes, pubs, a big Co-op & Lidl

Sundays on 1st & 8th September, try **Hutton-le-Hole Car Boot Sale** Depart 10.00, arrive 10.27, depart 12.05 arrive back 12.32. Or stay for a pub lunch and a walk and depart 17.35. There is a nice 2-hour circular walk from Hutton to **Lastingham, with its ancient church Crypt.**

Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays

Moorsbus is great for **walkers and runners**, doing linear walks/runs between stops. We have some bus walks on www.moorsbus.org, and links to other walks websites and you can download routes.

Please give us a try; tell your friends, relations and visitors!

Moorsbus have cheap single fares, starting from £1 and our all-day ticket is £9.50, we accept ENCTS passes, up to 4 children travel free with a ticket holder, dogs are welcome, our drivers are friendly and helpful. Buses are wheelchair accessible and most take contactless payments.
