A bus to Helmsley

From Thirsk, Northallerton, Easingwold and local villages you can now take a bus on Sundays and Bank Holidays to Helmsley with connections to many other parts of the North Yorks Moors. For example leaving Thirsk Market Place at 10.43 travel on the M5 Moorsbus via Coxwold, Byland Abbey and Ampleforth to Helmsley, arriving at 11.20. The M4 bus connects, leaving at 11.30 for Rievaulx Abbey. You could stay on the bus to Great Ayton and beyond but let's assume you get off to look around the abbey or take a walk. The M4 at 14.12 from Rievaulx will

take you all the way back to Thirsk - or get off in Helmsley to stay for two hours to visit the Walled Garden and return to Thirsk on the M5 bus, leaving at 16.30. Now, there is a recipe for a great day out without the car!

It is just one of many plans you can make with the Moorsbus timetable, available now in Thirsk's information centre.

Moorsbus is organised by just a few people running a charity but the services they contract are run by local bus companies. Because the services are nationally registered, English bus passes can be used on the Moorsbuses.
